### **Submission of Documents:**

- ✓ Candidate has to take the print-out of the duly filled-in application form and attach required documents mentioned as per below checklist. **(02 sets of self-attested Photocopies along with a set of original Documents)**
- ✓ Candidate/Parent/Guardian has to come personally to the Institute for submission of the duly filled-in application form along-with the required documents.
- ✓ **The application form will not be accepted in case of it is Incomplete or without having the required documents.**
- ✓ Last date for submission of duly filled application form is **7<sup>th</sup> June 2019.**

- ✓ H.S.C. Examination (10 + 2 or equivalent) Mark sheet
- ✓ JEE (Main) 2019 Admit Card
- ✓ JEE (Main) 2019 Score Card
- ✓ Passport Copy of NRI Sponsor (Sponsor's signature needs to be clearly visible)
- ✓ If passport of NRI Sponsor is Indian, then anyone of below document is required of NRI Sponsor:
  - NRI Certificate from Indian embassy of respective country.

- Immigration Stamps of more than 182 days stay outside India on sponsor's passport
  - NRI/NRE Bank Account Statement/Certificate in India
  - NRI IT Return filed in India
  - PR Card
- ✓ If passport of NRI Sponsor is of Foreign country, then anyone of below document is required of NRI Sponsor:
- OCI/PIO Card
  - NRI/NRE Bank Account Statement/Certificate in India
  - NRI IT Return filed in India
  - Cancelled Indian Passport
  - Indian School Leaving Certificate
  - Indian Birth Certificate
- ✓ **Original** Notarized affidavit of NRI Sponsor in prescribed format (available separately on PDPU website.)
- If affidavit procedure is being carried out in India (**On Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs. 100/-**) by NRI Sponsor, then the proof of the sponsor's presence in India at the time of affidavit is also to be submitted which may be in the form of a photocopy of those pages of passport bearing immigration stamp.
  - If the affidavit is being prepared in foreign country (**Stamp Paper is not required**), the sponsor has to follow the affidavit/notarization of respective country.
  - If provision of notarization is not available in a particular country, the sponsor has to get endorsed affidavit from Indian Embassy/Indian Consulate situated in the respective country.
  - **Signature made in affidavit must match with the signature made in passport of NRI Sponsor.**

- ✓ H.S.C. Examination (10 + 2 or equivalent) Mark sheet

- ✓ Any one of the following test score is required:
  - SAT-II Scorecard of Physics, Mathematics, & Chemistry
  - AP tests at A-levels in Physics, Mathematics & Chemistry
  - JEE (Main) 2019 Admit Card & Score Card
  - Equivalent standard examination of United Kingdom (UK) education system in Physics, Mathematics, & Chemistry
- ✓ School Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate
- ✓ Passport Copy of the candidate (signature needs to be clearly visible)
  - ✓ If passport is Indian, then anyone of below is required:
    - NRI Certificate from Indian embassy of respective country.
    - Immigration Stamps of more than 182 days stay outside India on candidate's passport
  - ✓ If passport is foreign nation, then anyone of below is required:
    - PIO Card
    - OCI Card
- ✓ Equivalent certificate from AIU, New Delhi is required if 12th std. is from foreign education board except CBSE, IB, Cambridge.
- ✓ Equivalent certificate from school authority (Where letter grades/ performance Index/ Grade Point Average is awarded at the qualifying examination)
